1. What should my camper bring?
 - a. Please label all belongings with child's name
 - b. A small backpack with a **refillable water bottle**, extra clothing (with plastic bag in case of accidents), swimsuit and towel for water play. Baseball caps are a good idea for sun protection.
 - c. A healthy snack (snacks will no longer be provided)
2. What should my camper leave at home?
 - a. Electronics, valuable/expensive items – there are times when bags are left out of sight
 - b. Toy guns of any kind
 - c. Clothes that you do not want to get dirty
3. What should my camper expect?
 - a. Arts & Crafts
 - b. Games (water games, too!)
 - c. Free time on the playground
 - d. Nature walks
 - e. Special theme days
4. Sunscreen/Bug Spray
 - a. Please apply sunscreen and bug spray to your child before you leave the house.
 - b. Counselors are not permitted to administer rub-on sunscreen to campers.
 - c. If your child burns easily, we suggest you pack a spray sunscreen and sunscreen stick so counselors can assist campers in reapplying, if necessary.
5. Driving in the Park
 - a. Please be aware and drive **SLOWLY** – kids at play!
6. Drop-Off
 - a. 9:00 AM (morning session) or 1:00 PM (afternoon session) at the **Concession Pavilion**
 - b. All drop-off will be curbside. Parents should remain in the vehicle. If a parent has a question or need assistance, please park and stand beside your vehicle and the Camp Director will come to you.
 - c. Please do not drop off your camper(s) earlier than 8:45 AM or 12:45 PM
 - d. Notify director of any new allergies, medical conditions, and/or injuries.
7. Pick-Up
 - a. 12:00 PM (morning session) or 4:00 PM (afternoon session) at the Concession Pavilion
 - b. To help ensure camper safety we require all parents have a pick-up pass. If your child is going home with someone else, they must have your camper's pick-up pass. There are no exceptions to this policy. Pick-up passes will be distributed by the Camp Director the first morning of camp.
 - c. After ten minutes, a \$10 late pick-up fee is charged.
