

Q. What day does my child go swimming?

A. Lower Campers (grades 1-5) go swimming on Wednesdays. Tracers (grades 6-9) swim on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Campers swim at Mermaid Lake swimclub.

Q. How do I add someone to the authorized pickup list?

A. You can turn in a signed note to your child's counselor adding a pick-up for a specific day or for the entire camp season. Phone calls, text messages and e-mails are not accepted.

Q. How much does pre/post care cost?

A. The daily rate for pre-camp is \$20. The daily rate for post-camp is \$25

Q. If my child forgets lunch, will they eat? What will it cost?

A. No child will be left unfed. They will be given a meal ticket and you will be invoiced \$8.

Q. What if my child forgets their shirt on a trip day?

A. Camp shirts are mandatory on trip days, if your camper forgets their shirt we will provide them with a shirt and you will be invoiced \$10.

Q. Is there any reason for my camper to bring money to camp?

A. Lunch may be purchased via the meal plan or a la carte so money may be needed for that. On Fridays the Kona Ice truck comes to camp and campers may purchase a water ice (\$3 - \$6). Additionally some fieldtrips have snack stands and gift shops that the campers are allowed to visit, parents may wish to send money with their camper for such items. We recommend putting the money in an envelope with your campers name on it and giving it to the counselor.

Q. Where does my child change for swimming?

A. Locker rooms are not available. Campers change in the school restrooms. We recommend campers wear their bathing suits to camp and only have to change after swimming. Campers may wear flipflops or sandals to swimming.

Q. How can I pay for camp, pre/post and lunch?

A. Payment can be made directly at camp via cash or check made out to Whitpain Township.

Q. Does my child need sneakers?

A. Campers should wear sneakers every day. We stress an Outside and Active philosophy.

Q. What should my child bring to camp every day?

A. Sunscreen, a water bottle and a good attitude. Campers should not bring tablets or other electronics.

Q. How does drop-off and Pick-up work? What about on trip days?

A. Drop-off is between 8:45 – 9:15 and occurs in the parking lot at the far end of the building near the playground. Parents may either park and walk their child to their counselor or simply let your child out. Pick-up runs from 2:45 – 3:15 for pick-up parents must park and walk over to their counselor and sign your child out. Remember, only authorized people may sign out your camper. On trip days campers may leave early or return late to camp. You will be notified prior to those trips and a text blast will be sent out when the campers are 30 minutes away from camp. Anytime a trip is leaving early or returning late campers and siblings may take advantage of our Kid's Club program at no charge.

Q. How do I pick up my child during camp hours?

A. Giving a note to your child's counselor the morning of will ensure that your child is in the camp office waiting for you. In an emergency you can call or come to camp and we will bring your child to the camp office.

Q. If it is raining where is drop-off and pick-up?

A. During inclement weather drop-off and pick-up are held in the school cafeteria.
