



Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to an exciting week of theatre! In Theatre Horizon's Summer Drama Camp, young actors spend a week working as an ensemble to create an original play - full of drama, comedy, suspense, and one-of-a-kind characters! Everything from the setting to the plot to the characters are created by the campers.

Campers will be guided through playwriting basics that foster collaboration and fun improv games that ignite each child's creativity. Each day, your child will participate in acting exercises, character development, and improv games to prepare for the final performance on Friday.

Some things to keep in mind for this week of Drama Camp:

- Camp begins promptly at **9:00 AM** and ends at **3:00 PM**. Please be on time dropping off and picking up your child(ren)
- If a child is not feeling well or if a family member has been exposed to COVID-19 or suspected COVID-19 within 14 days, they are not allowed to attend camp.
- As per current PA guidelines, students must wear masks during the camp day.
- Please see our Health and Safety guidelines for an overview of all COVID-19 policies and the daily check-in procedure.
- Each camper should bring a packed lunch, snack, and a bottle of water to camp each day. Staff cannot be responsible for providing students with food or for helping students to open food or drink containers.
- Campers should wear comfortable clothing and shoes. Please, no skirts or flip-flops.
- Please return the **Student Info Form** to the teachers no later than Tuesday.
- Please provide the instructor with a signed note at least one day in advance if your child will be picked up by someone not listed on your Student Info Form.
- On Wednesday or Thursday of this week, the instructors will work with the students to brainstorm costume ideas for Friday's performance. Costumes and props are the responsibility of parents. Costumes do not need to be purchased, and instead can be taken from the child's regular wardrobe, borrowed, or created!
- The final performance will be held this **Friday at 11:30 AM**. The performance will be recorded and shared via a Zoom link. More details will be shared in an email during the camp week.
- On the performance day, we ask that you bring a small treat for the cast party (baked goods, juice, chips, etc).
