

## PSCTA Guidelines for Parents and Students

We are excited to return to the courts! We have guidelines and rules that we will ask all of our students (and parents) to PLEASE follow so that we may maintain the safety of our students and staff. Our plans are conditioned upon compliance with ongoing and changing rules with government agencies and health safety. If we follow these guidelines we can safely get back on the courts and have some fun! Our staff will do all that we can to keep your children safe!

### Before Class

- Do not come to class if you or anyone in your household is sick or not feeling well.
- Handwashing (at least 20 seconds) and use of hand sanitizer is strongly recommended before and after play.
- Only bring necessary equipment (racquet and water bottle) to court.
- Review the guidelines provided with your child before attending every class.
- Wait until you are called for class so social distancing can be organized appropriately.
- Complete PSCTA waiver and bring to first class.

### During Class

- Parents are asked to remain for the duration of the lesson.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided on court and we will have your child sanitize at the beginning of class as well as during all water breaks.
- **Masks are currently required for staff and students per township guidelines.**
- Social distancing will be encouraged and practiced as much as possible during class.
- Outside areas around the court may be utilized by the staff to practice tennis and athletic skills.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Do not touch fellow students or student's equipment.

### After Class

- Leave the court as soon as you are dismissed.
- Use hand sanitizer or wash your hands thoroughly after leaving the court.
- Do not remain close to the courts after your lesson is over.
