



WHITPAIN TOWNSHIP

DEER MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES

- Hunters are only given permission to hunt the Whitpain Township controlled portion of the Armentrout Preserve.
- All hunters must possess a valid PA hunting license and appropriate antlerless tags.
- All hunts are archery only, crossbows are allowed.
- Regulation hunting hours will be followed, hunters are to be out of the preserve no later than 1 hour after sunset.
- All hunting must be done from a tree stand or saddle, no ground blinds are permitted.
- Tree stands must be removed by January 31st or they may be forfeit.
- Whitpain Township is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- No screw-in steps or hangers are permitted.
- No baiting of deer of any kind is allowed.
- Hunters must report their harvest by calling 610-277-2400 ext. 375 or emailing mrichino@whitpaintownship.org
- Hunters must drag their harvest manually, no use of ATV's or other equipment is allowed.
- Hunters must display their window placard while hunting.
- All other PA Game Commission laws apply.
- This is a pilot program, confrontation with other preserve users will likely hurt the chances of continuing or expanding this program.
- Failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in termination of hunting privileges.
- Be nice – be a steward of the outdoors.
